WLG TIMBER CABIN MEETS THE NEEDS OF MUSEUM OF WELSH LIFE

The Museum of Welsh Life in St Fagans has improved its education facilities by having a timber cabin installed in the grounds of the popular heritage attraction.

The Museum, which shows how the people of Wales lived, worked and spent their leisure time over the last 500 years, recently had a 15m x 4.5m timber cabin installed by national leisure contractor, Port Talbot based, Western Log Group (WLG).

Situated adjacent to the play areas, the timber cabin will provide an educational area to be used by school parties from the autumn, for which the museum is already receiving bookings.

Mark Richards, Director of Operations at the National Museums & Galleries of Wales commented: "We desperately needed a facility within the grounds to enhance the educational visits of the 92,000 pupils and students that we receive during a school year. With the continuing financial support of the Welsh Assembly Government we have been able to realise this facility. The Western Log Group's timber cabin matched our needs exactly by providing us with a venue which could be used in all weathers to teach the children, as well as catering for various other needs of the staff.
